Two Persons Charged In Murder Investigation

Sheriff's investigators have charged two persons today, Wednesday, January 25, in the murder of an elderly Claxton man. Sammie J. Adams, 79, of Patt Lane in Claxton, had been reported missing on Sunday, January 22. Adams' body was later found hidden underneath a staircase inside his apartment.

Sammie Adams' nephew, **Norman Lee Follis, Jr**, 48, has been charged with First Degree Murder and Felony Theft after the investigation into Adams' death. Follis' girlfriend, **Tammy Sue Chapman**, 43, also of Patt Lane, has been charged with Accessory After The Fact and Felony Theft. **Chapman** was also charged in an unrelated case with Aggravated Burglary for breaking into the home of Follis' father and step-mother. Additional charges may be filed on both **Follis** and **Chapman** as the investigation continues.
